



3-Year Limited Health Warranty

Buyer Responsibilities:

The Buyer must have the dog examined by a licensed veterinarian within seven days of receiving the dog. Seller must be informed within five days of the examination results. Information required includes the name/location of veterinarian performing the examination, the microchip identification of the dog, and any detrimental findings. If this initial examination and documentation is not provided within the allowed time, this warranty contract is cancelled.

The Buyer is responsible for associated veterinarian fees or other fees to define the defect for claims made under this warranty.

Any claims made under this warranty must be made in writing within three years from the purchase date on the sales receipt.

Health Warranty – What is Covered:

This dog is warranted for three years against fatal or severe life altering congenital disease which adversely affects the health of the dog. This includes severe hip dysplasia (which hampers the movement of the dog and natural gait and requires surgery to correct), ichthyosis (which causes skin scaling), kidney, heart, pancreas, spine, eyes, and liver problems of a severe life threatening or altering nature. If the dog has a definitive diagnosis by a licensed veterinarian within this three-year time frame, the Buyer must provide written documentation of the defect. Upon receipt of proper veterinarian documentation of the fatal or severe life altering congenital disease, Seller will refund the purchase price of the dog but does not require return of the dog.

Specifically in the case of hip or elbow dysplasia, an OFA or PennHIP diagnosis of moderate or severe dysplasia is required. Borderline Joint Conformation or Mild Dysplasia diagnosis are not covered by this warranty. Upon receipt by the Seller of OFA or PennHIP report documenting either moderate or severe dysplasia diagnosis, the Seller will refund the purchase price of the dog but does not require return of the dog.



Health Warranty – What is NOT Covered:

This warranty **does not cover** what is considered normal or preventable or related to environmental factors including but not limited to: heartworm, Canine Parvovirus (that is not present at initial veterinarian visit), Distemper, Coronavirus, Parainfluenza, entropion, ticks & fleas, vaccination reactions, ear infections, parasites or internal infections, skin or other allergies, thyroid dysfunction, demodectic mange, and other autoimmune disorders.

This warranty does not include infections of coccidia, Bordetella, and parainfluenza (Kennel Cough), which is common in puppies that are shipped.

This warranty does not cover any physical problem which is or could be the result of injury once the dog is received by the Buyer.

This warranty does not cover any medical examinations, procedures, treatment, medications, grooming, or other expenses incurred by the Buyer.

This warranty does not cover the temperament or intelligence of the dog, coat type/quality or shedding, appetite or expenses related to care and feeding, or any other reason not directly related to fatal or severe life altering congenital disease.

There is no warranty for the show-ability or breeding potential for this dog.

Additional Agreement:

All items covered under this warranty are limited to and by refund of purchase price only. The Seller cannot guarantee a replacement dog. The Seller does not require return of the dog in the case of death caused by, or diagnosis of severe congenital disease. In any case, the Seller's liability is limited to the purchase price of the dog only.

This warranty is not transferrable; it applies only to the original purchaser and cannot be transferred to another owner. The original purchaser must be the owner of the dog for the warranty to apply.
